How can we possibly show enough appreciation and

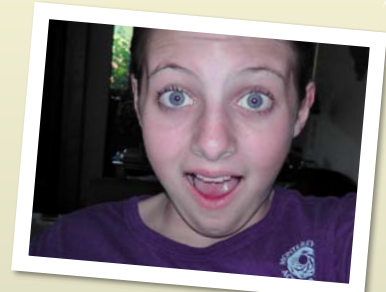
gratitude for the priceless gift God gave us in sending His son to bear the weight of a sinful world? Faithfulness, in every piece and part of our lives... this can be our response.
